Parent/Teacher Meetings

I have the wellbeing of all our children and staff to consider and I know you will understand the reason for my decision. We are delighted to continue sharing children's work and achievements with you via these classroom apps. They can also be used to send messages to your child's class teacher. However, all absence and messages regarding changes to collection or medical issues MUST be made delivered via email or telephone call via the School Office.

If you have made a change to the collection arrangements for your child, we request you call the school office by 3.00pm at the latest. Later messages cannot be guaranteed to reach the Class Teacher and may cause confusion at the end of the school day which can cause children distress.
