### **Cashless Payment System**

As you will be aware, we have launched our Cashless payment system and every parent should have received registration instructions and passwords by both email and letter. With effect from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021 (next Monday), we will no longer accept cash or cheques and will move over to this cashless system.

There are a range of advantages in taking this action, for parents, students and staff at the school - cash is not lost on the way to school, no need to go to the bank/cashpoint to get cash out and convenience - you can log into your account 24 hours per day to suit your lifestyle/other commitments. Our system has sophisticated fraud prevention and detection processes embedded within the software so you can be assured that your details are secure.

Please note, however, there will be certain specific occasions when we pass payment over to third parties (for example, the Christmas cards) and we will give these details as the occasions arise. Please let the office know if you have any queries or concerns.
