Anti Bullying Week – One Kind Word

This week is anti-bullying week - a week where we think about bullying. The week allows us to recognise it as well as preventing it from happening. During the last few days, every child in our school have created anti-bullying posters and a competition has been held for the most interesting ones. The theme for this anti-bullying week is "One kind word" where our teachers ask us about kind words and when we would use them, such as "please", "thank you" or "Good Morning."

During this week we have a part of school time dedicated to Personal and Social Education (PSE) were we have class discussions about this subject. Although I have never experienced bullying myself and haven't seen personally happening in St Philomena's the research says 30% of children have been bullied in last year alone in UK, and that's why talking about it is very important.

The aim of anti-bullying week is to raise awareness about this problem and I believe we have definitely achieved that in our school.

CHRISTMAS CARDS AND CHRISTMAS STAMPS

Some of the children have already asked whether or not they will be allowed to send cards this Christmas. While we make every effort to keep the children safe, we also want them to celebrate Christmas and all the magic it brings. With regard to Christmas Cards, we will need to ask that ALL CARDS must come through the School Post Box (not handed to individual Children and Staff). Children can bring the cards in with them (with the receivers name and year clearly marked on the envelope) and there will be specific times when they will be able to post them. The final date for posting will be **FRIDAY 10TH DECEMBER 2021. We cannot accept any cards after this date.**

Cards will be sorted by members of the school council and delivered to classrooms from Tuesday 14th December 2021 onwards.

For our Christmas Charity Fundraising we will once again be selling St Philomena's postage stamps. We charge 5p per stamp so for example, if your child chooses to send 20 cards to their friends, the outlay for stamps will be £1.00. Any additional donations will be passed directly onto the charity.

All money raised will go toward Crisis at Christmas. An individual would get:
