Teeth

Important information about your child's teeth from Bromley 0-19 Public Health Service

Dental advice for children and their families.

- Children should see a dentist as soon as their teeth start erupting.
- Then have regular check-ups every 6 months to a year depending on your dentist's advice.
- Children aged 3 and above may be entitled to free fluoride varnish; please ask your dentist for more information.
- Brush twice a day, last thing at night and any other occasion for two minutes.
- Parent's supervision is essential until 7 years of age.
- Use fluoride toothpaste (1350-1500ppm).
- . No need for children's toothpaste; adult toothpaste can be used straight away.
