Assembly Themes

This week's assemblies have followed the following themes:-

Monday

The Baptism of Jesus – a momentous occasion where we meet the family of God: the Holy Trinity. Using a painting, the assembly explored the Holy Trinity and helped children learn that God invites us into His family and be called His children – if we choose to accept the invitation!

Friday

Reception and KS1 – The Snowdrop – how this flower is a sign of hope for springtime. We watched an animated film about how brave the snowdrop is to be the first flower to grow.

KS2 – Why should I be good?

We watched a short animated film about Ben who found an 'Invisibility Ring'.

This was such an amazing assembly where children were so enthusiastic in sharing their ideas in response to questions such as:-

Should we only be good if there is a reward or treat? When is it difficult to make the right choice? Who are we being good for? How easy is it to face the consequences when we make the wrong choices?

Do speak to your children about these assemblies; you're guaranteed an interesting discussion!

<u>Message to motorists – Please DO NOT leave</u> your engine running whilst parked!

It has been bought to our attention that some parents/carers leave their engines running at drop off and pick up (particularly at the back gate).

Bromley has an "anti-idling campaign" – aimed at developing the children's awareness of ways to reduce the negative impact that the way we live has on our environment. Idling impacts greatly on the health of the whole community and we would like to work with our families to take this simple step towards improving the air quality around our school.

Research shows that concentrations around an idling diesel car are on average 2.6 times higher than ambient levels and higher at children's head height.

Poor air quality is a major health concern and as a major source of pollution is road transport, idling engines contribute to local air pollution.

The advice is to switch off your engine if parked or waiting for a minute or longer to help improve local air quality. It is a small change that will make a big difference.

Motorists find many reasons to keep their vehicle idling including the myth that stopping and starting is bad for the engine. Drivers also thought that idling on a yellow line is okay – although any illegal parking like this could result in a fine. These myths are not true, as modern engines for example, will not have a problem stopping and starting and by not idling, there is less fuel consumption and cost.
