- School have written to the council appealing for additional measures to be considered near the crossing

- Another parent works for an organisation called 'Traffic Watch' (Dante in Year 5's Mum – Carol) and has requested that they install an automatic traffic counter (ATC) outside school to provide us with some hard data to justify our concerns. They have agreed to do
