Use of Bicycles and Scooters

I am always delighted to see so many of our children riding their bikes and scooters to school. However, some children might need a few reminders NOT to ride them inside the school gates and also to ride them safely outside!

Here at St Philomena's we are very keen to reduce carbon emissions and promote physical activity and, therefore, encourage cycling and walking to school.

There are so many benefits to encouraging children to walk, cycle and scoot more regularly to school: It will reduce congestion and pollution around the school gates and it will also help your child's mental and physical health.

Teachers find that pupils who walk and cycle arrive at school more relaxed, alert and ready to start the day than those who travel by car.

However, it is even more important to keep our children safe – both the child cycling and others!

Please remind your children that they should always give way to pedestrians (as well as being courteous this is also a legal requirement).

We hope that this special day will enhance our children's mathematical skills and provide a memorable and enjoyable experience for everyone.







CAFOD Club


Cafod club visited Drake Court last week and we have received this email from them thanking our staff and children.
