Huge thanks for all the support we receive from parents for our PTA fundraising events. I am delighted that the fundraising efforts of our school community have enabled us to replace the laptops that we use for our Computing curriculum and many other areas of curriculum support. You will appreciate that this is no small investment and the purchase of 30 new (robust and functional) laptops was funded as follows:-

£ 7500 from the PTA £ 2500 from School Fund £ 2000 from Devolved Formula Capital (a ringfenced funding stream received from the government)

Many of our old laptops are failing but we will, of course, retain those that are still working to facilitate additional curriculum support.

Being able to update this valuable resource will benefit **ALL** of the children in our school and without your support and the amazing hard work of our PTA, this couldn't happen!
