

St Philomena Progression in Prayer

The Progression in Prayer document outlines our approach to prayer education, ensuring that by the time our children leave St. Philomena's, they are not only familiar with the core prayers of the Catholic faith, but also have a deeper understanding of the significance of prayer in their lives.

In addition to learning traditional prayers, we encourage children to engage in spontaneous prayer. They are taught to pray in various forms: for Blessing and Adoration, Petition, Intercession, and Thanksgiving. This holistic approach helps them build a well-rounded prayer life.

To further support our prayer practices, each classroom and main area within the school is equipped with a prayer table, which includes a Crucifix, a Statue or Icon, and the Bible. The focus of these prayer tables changes throughout the year, reflecting the Liturgical Calendar and the current topic being explored in Religious Education.
