We have had a great first few days and we are looking forward to an exciting rest of the term.

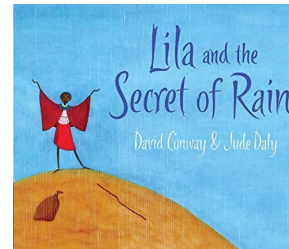
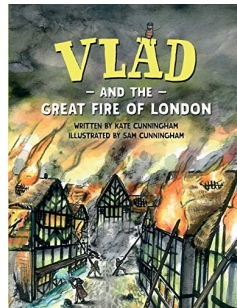
