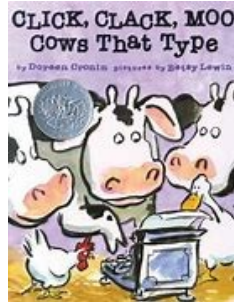
Info
