SCHOOL UNIFORM:

The Governors have agreed with the Head Teacher that school uniform is compulsory: It is important for the children's morale in that it gives them a sense of identity, and encourages pride in their appearance and an innate respect for the School to which they belong.

ALL ARTICLES OF CLOTHING, SPORTS WEAR AND BELONGINGS SHOULD BE CLEARLY AND SECURELY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.

BOYS & GIRLS

Winter coat or jacket – BLUE, royal if possible, navy or black (other colours MAY NOT be worn) – the material of the coat must be without pattern

Navy or black pacamac/mac in a sac

Royal blue/gold school tie*

Black shoes with no markings, lights or brand names

Aprons or protective clothing (eg an old shirt) for Art and Craft (needs to be plastic for Reception children)

For PE:

Black Plimsolls/Black trainers (must be completely black with no coloured/white markings or soles)

Blue T-shirt with school logo*

Navy* or black shorts for P.E.

Plain blue plimsoll bag

Please Note:

Royal blue, navy or black tracksuit trousers may be worn in winter for outdoor play and outdoor PE over normal school uniform or PE kit

During the winter, boys and girls may wear navy or black tracksuit trousers while travelling to and from school over normal school uniform - Jeans are not acceptable under any circumstances

Children will change into their uniform shorts or skirts before they go into class

BOYS

White shirt and school tie*

Royal blue v-neck jumper with school logo and gold stripe*

Short grey trousers - long trousers are not allowed

Grey, navy or black socks

GIRLS

White blouse or shirt – which must be worn with a school tie*

Royal blue v-neck jumper or cardigan with school logo and gold stripe*

Grey skirt or pinafore dress

School dress, royal blue stripe or check with collar and short sleeves - not the version that has shorts at the bottom - (to be worn in the summer)

White socks for the summer, and navy, black or grey tights or socks for the winter

- **NO TRAINERS SHOULD BE WORN IN SCHOOL BY BOYS OR GIRLS AS THEY ARE NOT PART OF OUR SCHOOL UNIFORM – UNLESS IT IS A PE DAY** ((must be completely black with no coloured/white markings or soles)
- **NO BOOTS ALLOWED TO BE WORN IN SCHOOL.**
- **FULL PE KIT TO BE WORN TO SCHOOL ON ALLOCATED PE DAYS.**
- ***SCHOOL V-NECK JUMPERS AND CARDIGANS, SCHOOL TIES AND BLUE PE T-SHIRTS WITH SCHOOL LOGO ARE TO BE PURCHASED FROM GRADUATES: SHOP ADDRESS 201 HIGH STREET, ORPINGTON, KENT, BR6 0PF. TELEPHONE NUMBER 01689 821439.**
- **HAIRSTYLES** should be neat and, if worn long, should be tied back in the interests of hygiene. Patterns or “tram lines” shaved into the hairstyle and “Mohicans” are not permitted. Make-up and nail varnish must not be worn.
- **NO JEWELLERY IS TO BE WORN** - this applies to any type of earrings, watches, bracelets, etc. and to boys and girls - as all of these can be potentially dangerous, particularly during PE. Simple analogue or digital watches to tell the time may be worn in year 6 only (not Smart Watches or other similar style watches with internet connectivity or which can be paired with mobile phones).
